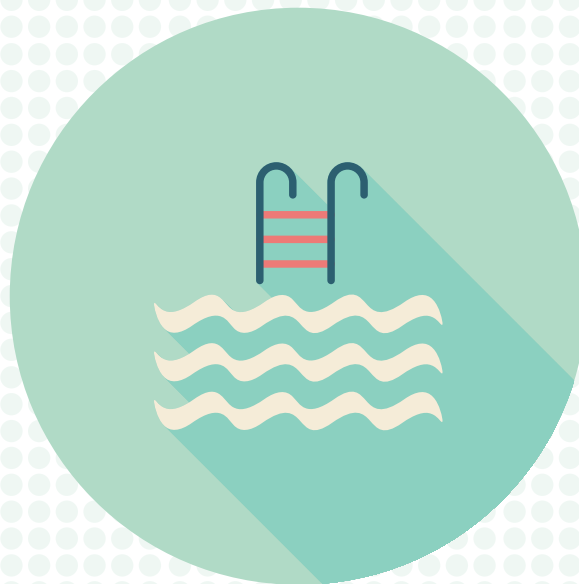

## THE VENUE
